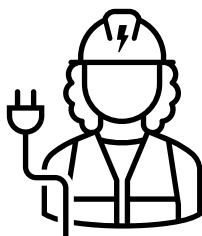


Now that you have programmed AL to get to the moon, let's learn a bit more about some of the exciting and important jobs there are in aerospace!

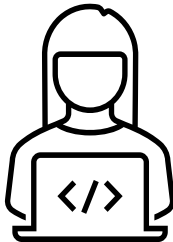

Description: This job involves developing algorithms, computer software, and aircraft computer systems. You need to test your algorithms carefully and debug if needed!
Important skills: Problem solving, planning, and creativity.

Research Scientist



A space research scientist conducts experiments and gathers research to help develop the aircraft and spacecraft used in aerospace. They also help to research and gather information about the climate in space.
Skills needed include teamwork, planning and adapting.

Mission Controller



Mission controllers help to launch spacecraft, they help to ensure they are running correctly and find and solve any problems that may occur. They help guide and control space flight.
Skills needed include communication, teamwork and speaking.

Sewing Machine Operator



A sewing machine operator helps to manufacture fabric things like parachutes and spacesuits. They must work with many different and sometimes heavy materials and must be confident using measuring tools.
Skills needed include problem solving, planning and creativity.

Astronaut



Astronauts travel with the spacecraft into outer space. They clean and repair equipment, conduct scientific experiments and record data. It is important they stay fit and healthy to travel into space.
Skills needed include adapting, leadership and problem solving.
